HISTORY OF THE HOUSE OF LIGHT CHURCH

The House of Light Church was founded in March 2016 by Ken J. Gordon, Jr. and Leslie A. Gordon in Burlington, NJ.

During a 21-day fast in January 2016 God spoke to Pastor Ken and Sis. Leslie, prompting them to plant a church in Burlington, NJ, which would promote salvation and sanctification and resist judging, intolerance, and religious tradition.

God revealed to the divine couple that the church would be a light for those in darkness and a place where the good works of its members would lead people to Christ. Matthew 5:16 – "Let your light so shine before men that they may see your good works and glorify your Father, which is in heaven" was the divinely inspired foundational scripture for God's new church plant. It was then that the name was revealed as – The House of Light.

Shortly after establishing the church in Burlington, NJ, Pastor Ken's career in Corporate America moved the couple to Birmingham, AL. After relocating to Birmingham, and during a 21-day fast in January 2018, God again impressed upon the couple to plant a House of Light church in Alabama. On May 6, 2018, Pastor Ken and Sis. Leslie opened the doors of their second House of Light Church. This one in downtown Birmingham, AL.

In 2021 the couple relocated from Birmingham, after seeking God for their next assignment. God led the couple to Charlotte, NC and on May 1, 2022, a third House of Light church opened its doors. This one was on the campus of an HBCU – Johnson C. Smith University.

And thus, God continues to inspire, lead, and touch lives through this House that sits upon a hill.

House of Light Church is founded upon Matthew 5:16: "Let your light shine before others, so they see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven".

We do this through actively reaching out and guiding our members to achieve their best life by making positive changes in body, mind, and spirit.

Ordinances

We believe, according to Scripture, that Jesus Christ commanded the observance of three ordinances before He ascended unto His Father in Heaven; namely the Lord's Supper (I Cor. 11:23-30), Feet Washing (John 13:3-9) and Water Baptism (Matt. 28:19). Only believers in Christ, those who give credible evidence of faith in Him, with works that follow, and those who believe in, and strive for sanctification and holiness, are entitled to participate in the Ordinances of the Church.

Prayer and Fasting

We believe in the power of prayer and fasting, according to Matthew 17:21. We fast on Wednesdays, from the time we rise until 5 pm. We start our Fast Day by anointing our head with blessed oil and washing our face, according to Matthew 6:17. While fasting, we consume water and pure juices. We also remain prayerful, praying at noon, and singing songs and hymns that keep us focused on Christ.

Organization

The House of Light Church subscribes to the Episcopal polity. As Christ is head of the Spiritual Church, the Pastor is head of the Natural Church. The Pastor is led by God, justified by Christ, and informed by the Holy Spirit, in the leadership of the church. All issues, natural and spiritual, are brought before the Pastor, who has determinative authority, as the overseer and spiritual leader of God's church plant.

Within the church corporation, the Pastor is the President and Chief Executive Officer. The church organization consists of a Board of Directors, which is responsible for fiduciary and corporate decisions, but does not oversee spiritual issues, of any kind.

TITHES & OFFERING

Tithes

- 10% of one's earnings, is the generally accepted amount, but is the minimum, not the maximum.

Members may give more, as led by God, for one can never lose their reward by giving to God's work.

Offering

- a monetary gift given in addition to tithes, which activates the overflow of God's blessings.

According to the Word of God, we are instructed to give tithes and offering, therefore, to do so is an act of obedience, not sacrifice. We believe when you do so, you are blessed and are obedient to God's word, according to:

- Malachi 3:10 Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. And try Me now in this," says the Lord of hosts, "If I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you such blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it. And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, so that he will not destroy the fruit of your ground, nor shall the vine fail to bear fruit for you in the field," says the Lord of hosts. "And all nations will call you blessed, for you will be a delightful land," says the Lord of hosts.
- **Genesis 28:30 22** Jacob made a vow, saying, "If God will be with me, and keep me in this way that I am going, and give me bread to eat and clothing to put on, so that I come back to my father's house in peace, then the Lord shall be my God. And this stone which I have set as a pillar shall be God's house, and of all that You give me I will surely give a tenth to You."
- **Matthew 23:23** "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you tithe mint and dill and cumin, and have neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice and mercy and faithfulness. These you ought to have done, without neglecting the others.
- ITimothy 5:17 18 Let the elders who rule well be counted worthy of double honor, especially those who labor in the word and doctrine. For the Scripture says, "You shall not muzzle an ox while it treads out the grain," and, "The laborer is worthy of his wages."

TITHES & OFFERTORY CONFESSION

- **4.** <u>Community</u> We were created to be relational, and this extends outside our church walls to those around us. (Genesis 2:18; Hebrews 10:24-25; Galatians 6:2; Matthew 18:20; Acts 2:46-47)
- **5.** <u>Concern</u> true ministry is selfless and intercessional, moving us from thinking only of our situation to caring for those God places in our lives. (Philippians 2:4; Ephesians 4:32; John 13:34–35)
